ARTICLE 1 – NAME

1.1 The name of the organization shall be Falcons Lacrosse, hereinafter referred to in this Constitution and its By-Laws as the “Association.”

1.2 The Association shall be a member in good standing of the Greater Winnipeg Lacrosse League (GWLL), Manitoba Lacrosse Association (MLA), Canadian Lacrosse Association (CLA), and Sport Manitoba.

ARTICLE 2 – HEAD OFFICE

2.1 The Head Office of the Association shall be located in the City of Winnipeg, Province of Manitoba, or at such other location as determined by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE 3 – JURISDICTION

3.1 The Association shall serve as the governing body for amateur lacrosse within its designated area of the City of Winnipeg, as defined by the policies and boundaries established by the Greater Winnipeg Lacrosse League.

3.2 The Association is recognized by the GWLL, MLA, CLA, and Sport Manitoba, and any successor organizations, as the governing authority for amateur lacrosse within its assigned zone.

ARTICLE 4 – MISSION AND OBJECTIVES

4.1 Mission

The mission of the Association is to develop, promote, and administer the sport of lacrosse in a manner that fosters enjoyment, fair play, and excellence, while providing meaningful opportunities for individual and team growth.

4.2 Objectives

The objectives of the Association are:

4.2.1 To promote the growth and long-term development of lacrosse within its designated zone.

4.2.2 To establish, implement, and enforce policies governing the administration and operation of lacrosse within the zone.

4.2.3 To encourage and support the development of high standards of skill, sportsmanship, and leadership among players, coaches, officials, and volunteers.

4.2.4 To provide a safe, inclusive, and positive environment for all participants.

ARTICLE 5 – PURPOSE

5.1 The Association shall operate as a non-profit organization. Its activities shall be conducted without financial gain for its members. Any surplus or accretions shall be used solely to further the mission and objectives of the Association.
